

# Cast Iron Chimneys from gusto

## Care instructions



Can be used as a grill



Congratulations on purchasing a gusto handmade garden chimney. in order to enjoy your new chimney for as long as possible, please follow closely the enclosed instructions.

**Not suitable for indoor use!**

## Safety

- **Caution: This cast iron chimney can become very hot.** Keep at a distance and make sure that no one comes closer than 50 cm to the chimney except when refuelling.
- **Warning: Make sure that children and pets stay away from the chimney.**
- Set up the chimney on a flat place which is protected from the wind. Make sure that all inflammable material is at least 2 meters away from the chimney.
- Never let the chimney burn without being attended to.
- Never use the chimney under canopies, in garages, under a carport, a balcony or similar.
- Do not use the chimney on flammable or heat sensitive surfaces.

## Lighting the cast iron chimney

- **Caution: Do not use liquid grill lighters. Please only use solid grill lighters, thin wood or paper.**
- Place 3 or 4 small pieces of wood in the middle of the chimney on the grid. To heat, it is best to use natural lighters or small branches, sticks, paper etc.
- Never put so much flammable material in the chimney that flames come up through the flue.

### Please note!

- Check the direction of the wind before you heat up the chimney.
- In some countries, it is illegal to burn garden waste. Please check your local laws and regulations.
- Allow the chimney to completely cool off before emptying or cleaning.
- Always allow the chimney to naturally cool off. Do not use water or other liquids to cool off.

## Maintenance and care

- Do not remove ashes and remainders of wood until the chimney is cold.
- Make sure that water does not remain inside the chimney.
- If you are not using the chimney, it should be stored in a dry place.
- Cast iron will rust when wet and under unfavourable weather conditions.
- This chimney is made of cast iron. Because of the material, it can tarnish and corrode. These spots can be treated with steel wool and polished. The area can be refreshed with the enclosed paint and the brush.
- Cast iron quickly rusts. This is not a defect or a reason for reclamation but a natural process.

### We recommend:

#### „gusto AntiOx“

- Rust Protector: For all cast iron materials which require rust protection. Repeat this treatment with gusto AntiOx if necessary.
