

# gusto firebaskets

## Instructions for use

Congratulations on purchasing a gusto handmade garden chimney.  
In order to enjoy your new chimney for as long as possible, please follow closely the enclosed instructions.

Before use, please read these instructions carefully.



### Safety

- **Caution: This fire basket can become very hot.** Keep at a safe distance and make sure that no one comes closer than 50 cm to the fire basket except when putting more wood in.
- **Warning: Make sure that children and pets stay away from the fire basket.**
- Set up the fire basket on a flat surface which is protected from the wind. Make sure that all inflammable material is at least 2 meters away from the fire basket.
- Never let the fire basket burn without being attended to.
- Never use the fire basket under canopies, in garages, under a carport, a balcony or similar.
- Do not use the fire basket on flammable or heat sensitive surfaces.

### Lighting the fire basket:

- **Caution: Do not use liquid grill lighters. Use instead solid grill lighters, thin wood or paper.**
- Place 3 or 4 small pieces of wood in the fire basket.
- To heat, it is best to use natural lighters or small branches, sticks, paper etc.

### Maintenance and care

- Do not remove ashes and remainders of wood until the fire basket is cold.
- If you are not using the fire basket, it should be stored in a dry place.
- Metal will rust when wet and under unfavourable weather conditions.
- This fire basket is made of metal. It is coated with a heat-resistant paint. Still, heat can cause it to tarnish and corrode. These spots can be treated with steel wool and re-painted with motorcycle muffler spray.
- Metal quickly rusts. This is not a defect or a reason for reclamation but a natural pr

#### Please note!

- Check the direction of the wind before you heat up the fire basket.
- In some countries, it is illegal to burn garden waste. Please check your local laws and regulations.
- Allow the fire basket to completely cool off before emptying or cleaning.
- Always allow the fire basket to cool off naturally.
- Do not extinguish with water or other fluids.
